US-1/Philips Highway Access to I-95 Northbound Detour Planned

Jacksonville – Florida Department of Transportation announces a detour of the US-1 / Philips Highway access to I-95 northbound will be in place beginning Friday, September 22 through Monday, September 25, weather permitting, as part of the I-95 Overland Bridge Project.

The detour is scheduled for 8 p.m., Friday through 6 a.m., Monday and is required for the contractor to perform drainage construction activities.

Motorists traveling to I-95 northbound from US-1 / Philips Highway will be directed to continue to Kings Avenue to Prudential Drive to San Marco Boulevard to Gary Street then back to I-95 northbound.

Motorists traveling to Downtown from US-1 / Philips Highway will be directed to continue on Kings Avenue to Prudential Drive to South Main Street then to the Acosta Bridge.
