48th Street and Tallulah Avenue to Close at Main Street Monday for Resurfacing Project Work

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT’s Main Street (U.S. 17) resurfacing project, which extends from State Street to the Trout River, 48th Street and Tallulah Avenue will be closed at Main Street from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday, Nov. 25 for paving operations.

During the closure, drivers will detour via 44th Street and Pearl Street. Flaggers will be onsite to direct motorists through the detour.

Hubbard Construction Co was selected to complete this \$20.8 million project, which is scheduled to be completed by early 2025.
