County Road 220 to Close Overnight Dec. 9-10 for First Coast Expressway Work

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – As part of First Coast Expressway construction, County Road 220 from east of Middleburg High School to Baxley Road will close overnight Monday, Dec. 9 and Tuesday, Dec. 10, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The roadway will close nightly at 9 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning. During the closure, through traffic will detour via Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) and Baxley Road. Access will remain available to local traffic.
