Detour Planned for the I-10 On-Ramp at Forest Street

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of FDOT’s I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, a long-term detour of the I-10 on-ramp at Forest Street will begin this afternoon and last until early fall while crews perform bridge construction activities, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers who wish to take the I-10 on-ramp at Forest Street will be detoured to Margaret Street/Edison Avenue, left on Claude Street/Irene Street and left at the signal to take the I-10 westbound on-ramp. Drivers who wish to take U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) will continue on Edison Avenue, and turn left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard. (See map below)



FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in early 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
