Detours Planned Next Week for State Road 223 Lighting Project

STARKE, Fla. – As part of the State Road 223 (Starke Truck Route) at State Road 100 lighting project, daytime detours are scheduled next week to adjust high-mast light poles on State Road 223.

Ramps at the interchange of State Road 100 and State Road 223 as well as the interchange of State Road 16 and State Road 223 will be closed Monday, Dec. 16 through Wednesday, Dec. 18 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Only one ramp will be closed at a time, and drivers should follow posted detours and use additional caution.

Traffic Control Devices, LLC. began the \$2.5 million lighting project in December 2023 and is estimated to complete the work by late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
