Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Sept. 10 through Thursday, Sept. 14 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed: Sunday, Sept. 10 through Thursday, Sept. 14 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

Stockton Street at I-10 closed: Sunday, Sept. 10 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound drivers will detour left on Roselle Street, right on King Street and right on Edison Avenue to reconnect with Stockton Street. Southbound drivers will detour right on Edison Avenue, left on King Street and left on Roselle Street to reconnect with Stockton Street.

I-10 East Exit to McDuff Avenue closed: Monday, Sept. 11 through Thursday, Sept. 14 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to the Stockton Street exit, right on Stockton Street, right on Irene Street, right on Edison Avenue, right on Forest Street and take the on-ramp to I-10 west to connect with McDuff Avenue.

Irene Street to I-10 West On-Ramp closed: Tuesday, Sept. 12 and Wednesday, Sept. 13 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to Edison Avenue, right on Edison Avenue, and right on Forest Street to connect with I-10 west on-ramp.

Cassat Avenue to I-10 West On-Ramp Closed: Wednesday, Sept. 13 and Thursday, Sept. 14 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound drivers will turn left on Highway Avenue and left on Lane Avenue to connect with I-10 west. Southbound drivers will continue turn right on Lenox Avenue, right on Normandy Boulevard and right on Lane Avenue to connect with the I-10 west on-ramp.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
