Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Feb. 4 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Feb. 4 through Thursday, Feb. 8 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-10 west exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed:**
Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Feb. 4 through Friday, Feb. 9 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-10 west exit to Cassat Avenue closed:**
Drivers will detour on I-10 to Lane Avenue, right on Lane Avenue, right on Highway Avenue to Cassat Avenue.

Closure scheduled Monday, Feb. 5 through Thursday, Feb. 8 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Luna Street on-ramp to I-10 east closed:**
Drivers will detour to Rayford Street, straight to McDuff Avenue, and take the I-10 east on-ramp.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
