Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Feb. 26 through Thursday, Mar. 2 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 East Exit to McDuff Avenue: Sunday, Feb. 26 through Thursday, Mar. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will continue on I-10 east to the Stockton Street exit, turn right on Stockton Street, turn right on Irene Street and take the I-10 ramp to connect with McDuff Avenue.

I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard): Sunday, Feb. 26 through Thursday, Mar. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

Nelson Street Detour: Tuesday, Feb. 28 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will use Lenox Avenue, Luna Street, Rayford Street, Herman Street. and Gilmore Street or Phyllis Street, Owen Avenue, Rayford Street, McDuff Avenue and Lenox Avenue to reconnect with Nelson Street.

Cassat Avenue to Westbound I-10 On-Ramp: Wednesday, Mar. 1 and Thursday, Mar. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. northbound drivers on Cassat Avenue will turn left on Highway Avenue and left on Lane Avenue to connect with I-10. Drivers on southbound Cassat Avenue will turn right on Lenox Avenue, right on Normandy Boulevard and right on Lane Avenue to connect with I-10.

I-10 East Exit to I-295: Thursday, Mar. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will continue on I-10 east, take the Lane Avenue exit, turn left on Lane Avenue, turn left onto the I-10 west on-ramp and continue to I-295.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
