Detours Scheduled from Dec. 8 to Dec. 12 as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Dec. 8 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Please note that schedules may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Dec. 8 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-10 West exit to McDuff Avenue closed: Drivers will detour to Luna Street and take Lenox Avenue to connect with McDuff Avenue.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Dec. 8 through Thursday, Dec. 12 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• Lane Avenue on-ramp to I-10 West closed: Southbound drivers will detour to Normandy Boulevard, to Lenox Avenue and take Cassat Avenue to connect with I-10. Northbound drivers will detour to Highway Avenue and take Cassat Avenue to connect with I-10.

Closure scheduled Monday, Dec. 9 and Tuesday, Dec. 10 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• U.S. 17 on-ramp to I-10 East closed: Drivers will detour to Roosevelt Boulevard, to Edgewood Avenue, to Plymouth Street and take McDuff Avenue to connect with I-10 East.

Closures scheduled Monday, Dec. 9 through Thursday, Dec. 12 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- Irene Street on-ramp to I-10 West closed: Drivers will detour to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.
- I-10 West exit to U.S. 17 closed: Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and take McDuff Avenue to connect with U.S. 17.

• **McDuff Avenue on-ramp to I-10 East closed:** Drivers will detour to Rosselle Street and take Stockton Street to connect with I-10 East.
