Detours Scheduled from March 16 to March 20 as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits Sunday, March 16 through Thursday, March 20 while crews perform construction work, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Please note that schedules may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Closure scheduled Sunday, March 16 to Wednesday, March 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) on-ramp to I-10 East closed:** Drivers will detour on Roosevelt Boulevard to McDuff Avenue north to access I-10 East.
- **I-10 West exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed:** Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and take McDuff Avenue to connect with U.S. 17.

Closure scheduled Sunday, March 16 to Thursday, March 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **Irene Street on-ramp to I-10 West closed:** Drivers will detour to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.

Closure scheduled Monday, March 17 to Thursday, March 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **Lane Avenue on-Ramp to I-10 West closed:** Southbound Lane Avenue drivers will detour to Normandy Boulevard to I-295 North and access I-10. Northbound Lane Avenue drivers will continue to Commonwealth Avenue to I-295 to access I-10.
- **I-10 West exit to I-295 closed:** Drivers will detour to Hammond Boulevard, left on Hammond Boulevard and left on Normandy Boulevard to access I-295.

Closure scheduled Thursday, March 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **I-10 West exit to McDuff Avenue closed:** Drivers will be detoured to Luna Street, left on Luna Street to I-10 East to reconnect with McDuff Avenue.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in summer 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
