Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Jan. 29 through Tuesday, Jan 31 while crews perform bridge construction and overhead sign operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard): Sunday, Jan. 29 through Tuesday, Jan. 31 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

I-10 East Exit to I-295: Sunday, Jan. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers on I-10 east who wish to take the I-295 off-ramp will continue on I-10 east, take the Lane Avenue exit, turn left on Lane Avenue, turn left onto the I-10 west on-ramp and continue to I-295.

Lane Avenue to I-10 East On-Ramp: Monday, Jan. 30 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers headed north on Lane Avenue who wish to connect with I-10 west will continue on Lane Avenue, take a right on Highway Avenue and take a right on Cassat Avenue to connect with I-10. Drivers headed south on Lane Avenue who wish to connect with I-10 west will take the I-10 east on-ramp, exit at Cassat Avenue and take a left to connect with I-10 west.

I-10 West Exit to Luna Street: Monday, Jan. 30 and Tuesday, Jan. 31 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit, right on McDuff Avenue, left on Highway Avenue to connect with Luna Street.

Nelson Street Detour: Tuesday, Jan. 31 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will use Highway Avenue or Rayford Avenue to Union Hall Place and Luna Street to reconnect with Nelson Street.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
