Detours, Lane Closures Planned on Jacksonville Bridges this Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Motorists can expect to see detours and lane closures on several major Jacksonville bridges this week as crews perform routine maintenance.

- **Main Street Bridge (U.S. 1):** The Main Street Bridge will be closed in both directions from 9 p.m. Sunday, October 10 through 5 a.m. Monday, October 11. Motorists may use the Acosta Bridge as an alternate route.
- **Buckman Bridge (I-295 South):** Nightly single and double lane closures will be in place from 9:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Monday, October 11 and Tuesday, October 12.
- **Dames Point Bridge (I-295 North and South):** Daytime single lane closures will be in place from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday, October 11 through Saturday, October 16.

Drivers should anticipate congestion in these areas and consider alternate routes when possible.
