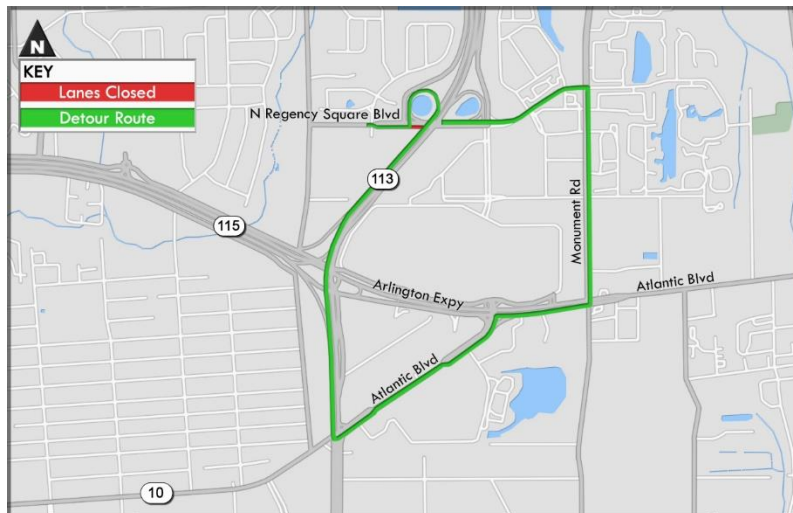

Eastbound Lanes of Regency Square Boulevard North at Southside Connector Closed February 15

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Eastbound lanes of Regency Square Boulevard North from Kendall Drive to Gilmore Heights Road at the Southside Connector interchange will close Monday, February 15 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. for drainage work related to the Southside Connector resurfacing project.

Eastbound Regency Square Boulevard traffic will detour south on the Southside Connector (State Road 113) via the southbound ramp to Southside Boulevard, east on Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) and north on Monument Road to Regency Square Boulevard East. (Detour and closure shown in map below.)



Motorists are reminded to follow detours and stay outside the construction zones.
