FDOT to Hold Hearing on Proposed Changes to Atlantic Boulevard/3rd Street Intersection

Jacksonville, Fla. – A public hearing regarding proposed changes to the roadway, signalization, striping and medians at the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) and 3rd Street (State Road A1A) will be held Tuesday, June 18 at the Beaches Branch Library, 600 3rd Street, Neptune Beach, Florida, 32266. Attendees will have the opportunity to view displays and discuss the proposed changes with FDOT staff during an open house from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. A formal public comment period will begin at 6:30 p.m.

Proposed improvements include restriping, minor widening and median changes to adjust traffic movement through the intersection, as well as removing the top layer of asphalt and resurfacing of 710 feet of roadway around the intersection.

Project documents will be available for review at the public hearing and are currently posted at nflroads.com. Attendees who complete a speaker's card will be given the opportunity to make an oral statement that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits in place of or in addition to oral statements may do so at the hearing or by sending them to Jeff Daugharty, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before June 28, 2019 will become part of the hearing record.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
