FDOT to Host Construction Open House for S.R. 21 Improvement Project

Blanding Boulevard widening project expected to start construction in January 2019


Clay County – The Florida Department of Transportation will host a construction open house December 10 to preview upcoming improvements to State Road 21 (Blanding Boulevard) from Allie Murray Road to Long Bay Road in Clay County.

The open house will be held at the Middleburg Civic Association, 2102 Palmetto Street, Middleburg, FL 32068 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. FDOT staff and consultants will be available to answer questions about the project.

Project improvements include widening the roadway to six lanes, adding four-foot wide bike lanes and six-foot wide sidewalks in both directions, replacing traffic signals and street lighting, constructing a new drainage system and realigning the Blanding Boulevard/County Road 220 and Blanding Boulevard/Long Bay Road intersections.

R.B. Baker Construction is the contractor for the \$19.1 million project, which is scheduled to begin in January 2019 and be completed by spring 2021, weather and schedule permitting.
