
Public Invited to Give Input on Proposed Changes to State Road 211 in Avondale

Jacksonville, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will host a hearing to discuss proposed changes to the roadway, striping and medians on State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue/Herschel Street) between Canterbury Street and Melrose Avenue, Financial Project Number 443551-1. The hearing is Wednesday, January 22 at the FDOT Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. It will begin with an open house from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m., followed by a formal public comment period at 6:30 p.m.

Proposed improvements include replacing two signalized intersections with roundabouts at St. Johns Avenue/Herschel Street/Geraldine Drive and St. Johns Avenue/Herschel Street just south of Woodmere Drive.

Project documents will be available for review at the public hearing and at www.nflroads.com by January 17, 2020. Attendees who complete a speaker's card will have the opportunity to make an oral statement that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits in place of or in addition to oral statements may do so at the hearing or by sending them to Jeff Daugharty, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before February 1, 2020 will become part of the hearing record.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
