FDOT to Host Hybrid Public Hearing on Proposed Changes to 103rd Street at Blanding Boulevard and Jammes Road

Jacksonville, Fla. – FDOT will host a hybrid public hearing to discuss proposed median modifications on 103rd Street (State Road 134) at Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) and 103rd Street at Jammes Road in Jacksonville, Florida.

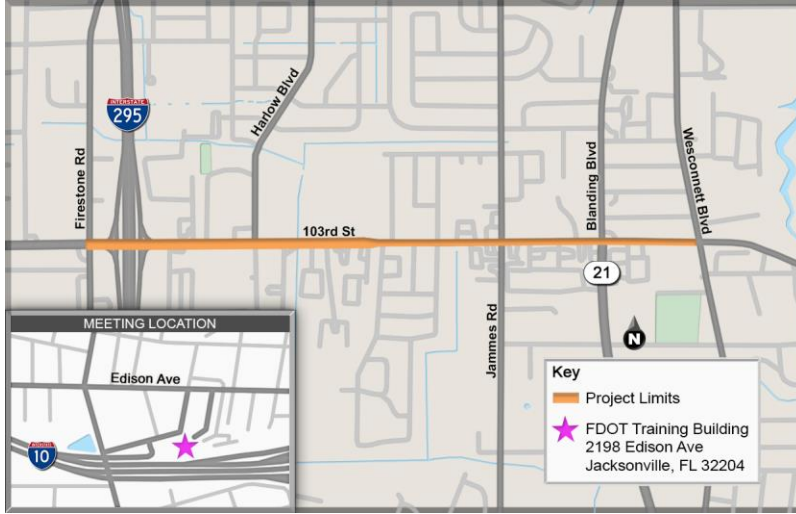
The hybrid hearing will be held September 24, 2020, with an informal open house from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. and a formal presentation beginning at 6 p.m. Citizens may participate online at nflroads.com/VPH or by phone at **(562) 247-8321** using access code **661 901 696**. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center located at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. Due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, citizens are strongly encouraged to use the virtual options.

FDOT proposes the following modifications:

- Directionalize the median at 140th Terrace
- Extend the eastbound left turn lane at 138th Terrace to accommodate U-turns
- Extend the westbound left turn lane at 143rd Street to accommodate U-turns
- Construct a traffic separator along the eastbound left turn lane at 103rd Street and Jammes Road

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nflroads.com/VPH. Citizens may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits by sending them to Victor Marrero P.E., Project Manager, via email at Victor.Marrero@dot.state.fl.us or traditional mail at 1109 S. Marion Street, Lake City, FL 32025. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before October 4, 2020 will become part of the public hearing record. Project-related documents are currently available for review at nflroads.com/VPH.
