## FDOT to Host Nov. 3 Public Meeting for Proposed Atlantic Boulevard at Sutton Lakes Boulevard Median Modifications

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a hybrid public meeting Thursday, Nov. 3 to discuss permit-related median modifications proposed for the Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) and Sutton Lakes Boulevard intersection.

The meeting will be held in person at the FDOT Training Facility at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204 and virtually. FDOT staff and the permit applicant will be available to answer questions during the open house period from 4 to 6 p.m. Interested parties wishing to submit comments for the record may do so during the public comment period beginning at 6 p.m.

The proposed changes include modifying the traffic signal at Sutton Lakes Boulevard to accommodate a new permitted roadway on the north side of Atlantic Boulevard between Duval Acura and Land Rover.
