Flagging Operations Scheduled for Northbound Lanes of U.S. 17

PALATKA, Fla.- As part of the Dunn's Creek roadway widening project, flagging operations and lane closures will be in place for the northbound lanes of U.S. 17 Thursday, June 24 through Friday, July 2 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., weather and schedule permitting.

The northbound lanes of U.S. 17 will be closed intermittently under flagging operations to complete median work on the project between the following locations:

- U.S. 17 northbound from Hoot Owl Road to just south of the Dunn's Creek Bridge
- U.S. 17 northbound from Butler Drive to Pineway Avenue
- U.S. 17 northbound from Pineway Avenue to just south of Horse Landing Road

GLF Construction is estimated to complete the \$36.5 million roadway widening [project](#) by summer 2021. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.
