### Hart Expressway from Atlantic to University Boulevards Closed Tuesday Night

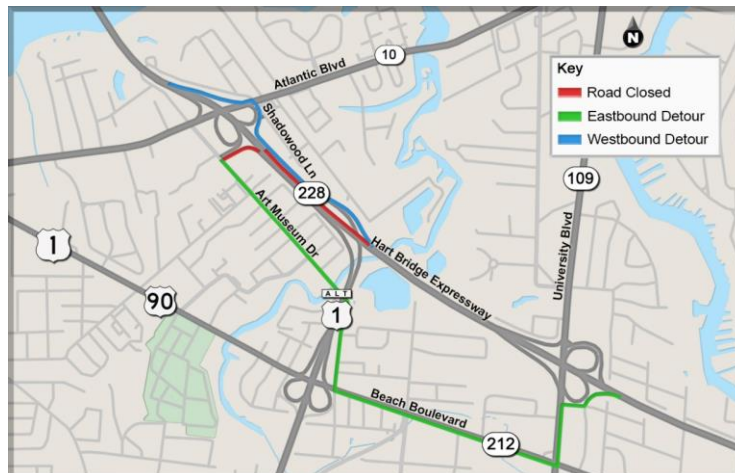
**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Hart Expressway (State Road 228) from Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) to University Boulevard (State Road 109) will be closed to traffic Tuesday, October 27, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. for work related to the Hart Expressway Landscaping project.

Westbound Hart Expressway traffic will detour to Atlantic Boulevard and take the Hart Bridge on-ramp just west of the Atlantic Boulevard and Shadowood Lane intersection.

Eastbound traffic will detour to Art Museum Drive, Beach Boulevard (State Road 212) and University Boulevard South to the Hart Expressway eastbound on-ramp.

Lane closures along the route will be in effect starting at 7 p.m. with all lanes open by 7 a.m. Wednesday.
