I-10 East from U.S. 301 to State Road 23 Closed Overnight February 28

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The eastbound lanes of I-10 from U.S. 301 to First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) are scheduled to close overnight Sunday, February 28 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for work related to the Yellow Water Road Bridge replacement project.

Eastbound I-10 traffic will detour to Beaver Street (U.S. 90) via Baldwin Bypass/State Road 201 and continue to the State Road 23/First Coast Expressway exit to I-10 East (shown in the map below).
