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I-10 Eastbound Exit Ramp to U.S. 301 to Close Overnight September 13 for Paving Work

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvement project, the I-10 eastbound exit ramp to U.S. 301 ramp will be closed Sunday, September 13 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for paving work on the ramp, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 eastbound traffic wishing to exit on U.S. 301 will continue east on I-10 and detour via State Road 23 (Exit 350B) and travel back westbound on I-10 to exit to U.S. 301 (Exit 343).

Motorists are encouraged to adhere to posted regulatory signs and stay alert while driving through active construction zones.

Superior Construction Company began the \$65 million interchange improvement project in late February 2016 and is estimated to complete the work in spring 2021. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.

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
