### Overnight Closures on I-10 West from Cecil Commerce Parkway to U.S. 301 Scheduled Next Week

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The westbound lanes of I-10 from Cecil Commerce Parkway (State Road 23/First Coast Expressway) to U.S. 301 in Baldwin are scheduled to close overnight Monday, December 14 through Thursday, December 17, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting, for work related to the Yellow Water Road Bridge replacement project.

Traffic will detour to Beaver Street (U.S. 90) west via the Exit 350 ramp and continue to the U.S. 301 ramp back to I-10 West (shown in the map below).
