I-10 West to Luna Street Exit to be Detoured Overnight September 7

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT’s project to widen I-10 from I-295 to I-95, an overnight detour of the I-10 west to Luna Street exit ramp will be in place Tuesday, September 7 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 West to Luna Street Detour: Drivers will continue on I-10 west, take the Cassat Avenue exit, turn right on Cassat Avenue and turn right on Highway Avenue to access Luna Street.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
