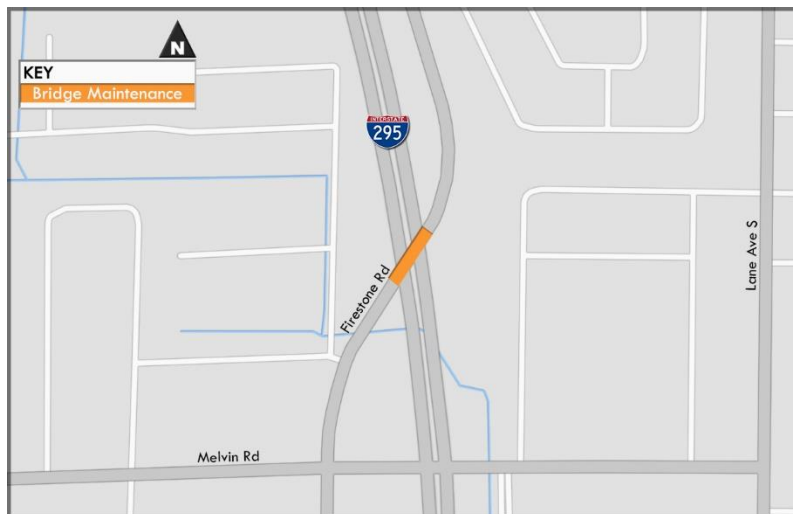
## I-295 Overpass at Firestone Road Bridge Maintenance Project to Start

**Jacksonville, Fla.** – The I-295 West Beltway overpass at Firestone Road will undergo routine bridge maintenance and rehabilitation beginning March 4.

The contractor will work weekdays and weekends starting at 7 a.m. Single and double lane closures on I-295 will occur Sunday through Thursday nights from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. The speed limit of 65 mph will be reduced to 55 mph during all lane closure activity. Drivers will be notified in advance of the speed limit reduction via digital message boards.

The \$540,000 project was awarded to Gulf Coast Contracting LLC. It is expected to be completed in summer 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
