I-295 Ramps at Normandy Boulevard, Wilson Boulevard and 103rd Street Scheduled for Overnight Closures Dec. 8 to Dec. 12

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s I-295 at Normandy Boulevard operational improvements and I-295 from Morse Avenue to U.S. 90 resurfacing projects, the I-295 northbound ramp to Normandy Boulevard is scheduled to be closed from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 8 through Thursday, Dec. 12 for resurfacing operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. During the closures, drivers will continue north on I-295, exit onto eastbound I-10, then take southbound Lane Avenue and proceed to Normandy Boulevard.

Additionally, the northbound and southbound I-295 ramps to Normandy Boulevard, Wilson Boulevard and 103rd Street are scheduled to be closed nightly for Wrong Way Vehicle Detection System (WWVDS) testing from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, Dec. 10 through Thursday, Dec. 12, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Drivers should follow posted detours and use additional caution in the area.
