

I-295 Westbound at I-95 North Interchange Detoured Tonight

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will detour a portion of I-295 westbound tonight from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and schedule permitting, as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Project.

As shown in the map below, traffic on I-295 westbound at I-95 will be detoured onto I-95 northbound to the Airport Road exit, then onto I-95 south where drivers can access I-295 westbound.



The I-95 northbound to I-295 westbound ramp will also be closed tonight, drivers will follow the same detour.

The Florida Department of Transportation's I-95/I-295 North Interchange Project will modernize and reconfigure the I-95/I-295 North interchange to improve traffic flow, safety and increase capacity.
