I-95 Ramp Closures at Pecan Park Road Scheduled Sunday and Monday Nights

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the widening project on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard, the I-95 entrance and exit ramps at Pecan Park Road (State Road 243) will be closed Sunday, October 6 and Monday, October 7 for roadway reconstruction work.

Sunday, October 6 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Pecan Park Road will be closed. Southbound traffic will continue south and detour to exit at Airport Road and travel I-95 northbound to exit on Pecan Park Road.

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Pecan Park Road will be closed. Motorists will detour from I-95 northbound to State Road 200 to return southbound on I-95.

Monday, October 7 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Pecan Park will be closed. Motorists will detour from I-95 northbound to State Road 200 to I-95 south to travel back to Pecan Park Road and exit.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Pecan Park Road will be closed. I-95 northbound traffic from Pecan Park Road will utilize the I-95 southbound entrance, exit at Airport Road and travel back to I-95 northbound.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. began the \$17.4 million widening project in July 2017 and is expected to complete the project by fall 2019, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
