

I-95 Southbound Lane from 8th Street to 5th Street Closed Tonight

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – One southbound lane of I-95 from 8th Street to south of West 5th Street, including the 8th Street on-ramp to I-95 southbound, will be closed tonight, weather permitting, Monday, Oct. 17, from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, Oct. 18 for work related to the recent repair project on the I-95 West 5th Street overpass.

For the 8th Street ramp closure, traffic will detour to either Myrtle Avenue North and Kings Road/Union Street or North Davis Street and State Street to I-95 southbound.
