### **Intersection Improvements at Beaver and Broad Streets to Start Next Week**

**Jacksonville, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation’s Beaver Street (U.S. 90) and Broad Street Traffic Signal Update project will begin next week.

In addition to a traffic signal update, the project includes sidewalk and signage upgrades near the intersection.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. There will be no lane closures between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 10 p.m.

FDOT selected American Lighting and Signalization, LLC to complete this \$417,000 project in summer 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
