Landscaping Improvements on S.R. 201 in Baldwin set to Begin September 7

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a landscaping improvement project on State Road 201 from south of the Town of Baldwin to just north of the newly constructed Baldwin Bypass September 7, weather and schedule permitting.

The landscaping improvements will include planting Live Oak trees, Bald Cypress trees, other various shrubs and trees and installing a temporary irrigation system.

Arazoza Brothers Corporation was selected to complete the \$1 million landscaping improvement project by early 2022, not including a two-year establishment period. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.
