Landscaping Underway at First Coast Expressway/I-10 Interchange

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Work on a landscaping project at the I-10 and First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) interchange began Monday, May 10.

LaFleur Nurseries and Garden Center LLC was selected to complete the approximately \$1 million project, which includes installation of temporary irrigation systems and planting of Eagleston Holly, Southern Magnolia, Natchez Crape Myrtle, Densa Pine, Bald Cypress and Live Oak trees. Construction is estimated to be completed in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, with a two-year establishment period to follow.

Construction activities will take place primarily during daytime hours Monday through Friday. No single lane closures will be permitted from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday. No double lane closures will be permitted from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday. No lane closures will be permitted from 6 a.m. Friday through 9 p.m. Sunday.
