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Lane closures scheduled Tuesday night to relocate crane across I-10

Jacksonville – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvements, construction crews will be relocating a 275-ton crawler crane Tuesday, July 11 between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. from the south side of the roadway to the north side of the roadway to continue interchange improvements, weather and schedule permitting.

In order to relocate the crane, east and westbound lane closures on I-10 between Yellow Water Road (CR 217) and U.S. 301 will be in place.

Law enforcement will also be on-site to assist in traffic pacing (rolling road block) as temporary traffic control.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) selected Superior Construction Company to complete the \$65 million interchange improvements in late February 2016. The construction is estimated for completion in summer 2019, schedule permitting.

FDOT strives for safe construction zones. Travelers need to be aware of heavy equipment and stay within the limits of the orange cones and barrels.
