

New Traffic Pattern on Westbound Collins Road Begins October 7

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s interchange improvement project at I-295 and Collins Road, vehicles traveling westbound along Collins Road will be shifted overnight Wednesday, October 6 onto the newly constructed westbound lanes as shown in the map below. This shift will enable crews to construct the jug handle lanes that will ultimately provide access from eastbound Collins Road to northbound I-295.



FDOT hired J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete this \$6.4 million project in late 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
