Nighttime detours ahead for Pecan Park ramps at I-95

Jacksonville – As the Florida Department of Transportation continues widening improvements on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard, preparations to safely install barrier wall at I-95 will begin Sunday, April 15 through Tuesday, April 17. To complete this work, detours will be in place each night from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Sunday, April 15:

- I-95 northbound exit ramp traffic will be detoured to exit at State Road 200 (Exit 373) in Nassau County to travel south on I-95 and exit Pecan Park Road.
- I-95 southbound on ramp traffic will be detoured north on I-95 to exit at State Road 200 in Nassau County to travel south on I-95.

Monday, April 16:

- I-95 southbound exit ramp traffic will be detoured to exit at Airport Road (Exit 363) to travel north on I-95 and exit at Pecan Park Road.
- I-95 northbound on ramp traffic will be detoured south on I-95 to exit at Airport Road to travel north on I-95.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. began the \$17.4 million widening project July 10, 2017 and are expected to complete the reconstruction work in late 2018, schedule permitting.
