Nighttime lane closures scheduled for I-10 construction work at U.S. 301

Jacksonville – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvements, construction crews will implement lane closures and traffic pacing operations Tuesday, August 8 from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and schedule permitting.

Single and double lane closures are set for east and westbound travel lanes of I-10 between Yellow Water Road (C.R. 217) and U.S. 301.

Law enforcement will also be on-site to assist in traffic pacing (rolling road block) as temporary traffic control.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) selected Superior Construction Company to complete the \$65 million interchange improvements in late February 2016. The construction is estimated for completion in summer 2019, schedule permitting.

FDOT strives for safe construction zones. Travelers need to be aware of heavy equipment and stay within the limits of the orange cones and barrels.
