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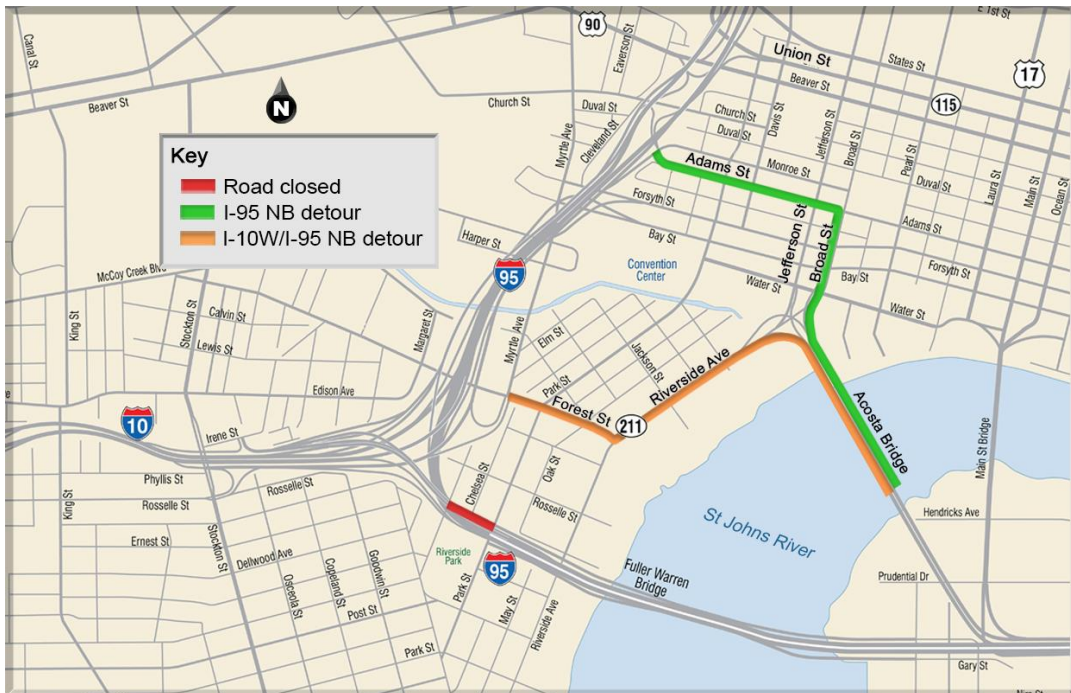
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Detour Planned for I-95 North at the Fuller Warren Bridge

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s 1-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, I-95 northbound will be detoured Wednesday, February 12 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. as crews pour concrete on the I-95 northbound to I-10 westbound ramp, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-95 Northbound: Traffic will be detoured to the downtown exit ramps and onto the Acosta Bridge. From the Acosta Bridge, drivers will take a right onto Broad Street and then a left onto Adams Street where they can travel north on I-95 or west on I-10.

I-10 Westbound/I-95 Northbound Alternate: Traffic will be detoured to the downtown exit ramps and onto the Acosta Bridge. From the Acosta Bridge, drivers will exit onto Riverside Avenue and turn right onto Forest Street where they can access I-10 westbound or I-95 northbound.



Law enforcement officers will be on site to ensure the safety of drivers and construction crews.

FDOT hired Archer Western as the contractor to complete this \$126 million project with completion anticipated in early 2021, depending on weather, holidays and unforeseen circumstances.
