## Overnight Closures of I-295/Beach Boulevard Ramps Planned April 14-18

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla. –** As part of the widening and resurfacing improvement project on I-295 from J.T. Butler Boulevard (SR 202) to Beach Boulevard (SR 212), nightly closures of the I-295 southbound on-ramp from Beach Boulevard are planned Sunday, April 14 to Thursday, April 18. Additionally, an overnight closure of the I-295 northbound exit ramp to Beach Boulevard is planned Thursday, April 18. The ramps will close at 10 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning.

<u>Detour to I-295 Northbound:</u> Drivers will detour via westbound Town Center Parkway, northbound St. Johns Bluff Road and eastbound Beach boulevard to access the I-295 northbound on-ramp.

<u>Detour to I-295 Southbound:</u> Drivers will detour via westbound Beach Boulevard, southbound St. Johns Bluff Road and eastbound Town Center Parkway to access the I-295 southbound on-ramp.

Hubbard Construction Company, Inc. is expected to complete the \$19 million improvement project in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
