Overnight Closures of Ramp from Eastbound Hart Expressway to Southbound University Boulevard Planned March 25-26

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on University Boulevard (State Road 109) from Cruz Road to Wateredge Lane, closures of the ramp from eastbound Hart Expressway (State Road 228) to southbound University Boulevard (State Road 109) are planned Tuesday, March 25 and Wednesday, March 26, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closures will begin nightly at 8 p.m. and end by 6 a.m. the following morning. As a detour, drivers will exit the Hart Expressway at Beach Boulevard and use eastbound Beach Boulevard to access University Boulevard.

Watson Civil Construction, Inc. was awarded the contract for this \$6.85 million project, which includes milling and resurfacing 1.8 miles of roadway, pavement and curb reconstruction, signage, pavement markings, concrete sidewalks, guardrail replacement, pier protection, ADA detectable warning devices, stormwater drainage, signalization and lighting/light pole installation. The project is estimated for completion in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
