## Overnight Detour Planned Next Week at I-95 South Entrance from State Road 16

Traffic shift to new I-95 South entrance ramp to occur

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla.** – As part of intersection improvements on State Road 16 at I-95, an overnight detour of the I-95 South entrance ramp from State Road 16 is necessary for a traffic shift to be completed safely. The I-95 South entrance ramp will close overnight Sunday, Nov. 24 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. the following morning.

During this time, drivers on State Road 16 will follow posted detour signs to use I-95 North to International Golf Parkway to access I-95 South.

Drivers will have access to the newly constructed I-95 South entrance ramp next week, shifted farther east.

Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the area and follow posted detour signs at these times. Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by mid-2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
