Overnight Detour of Bay Street Planned October 23-25

NEPTUNE BEACH, Fla. – As part of construction of pedestrian improvements at State Road A1A (3rd Street) and Bay Street in Neptune Beach, overnight closures of Bay Street east of State Road A1A are planned Sunday, Oct. 23, Monday, Oct. 24 and Tuesday, Oct. 25. The roadway will close each evening at 8 p.m. and reopen by 8 a.m. the following day. The closures are necessary to allow for installation of drainage structures and pipe.

During the closures, traffic will be detoured via Pine Street, Second Street and Magnolia Street as shown in the map below.
