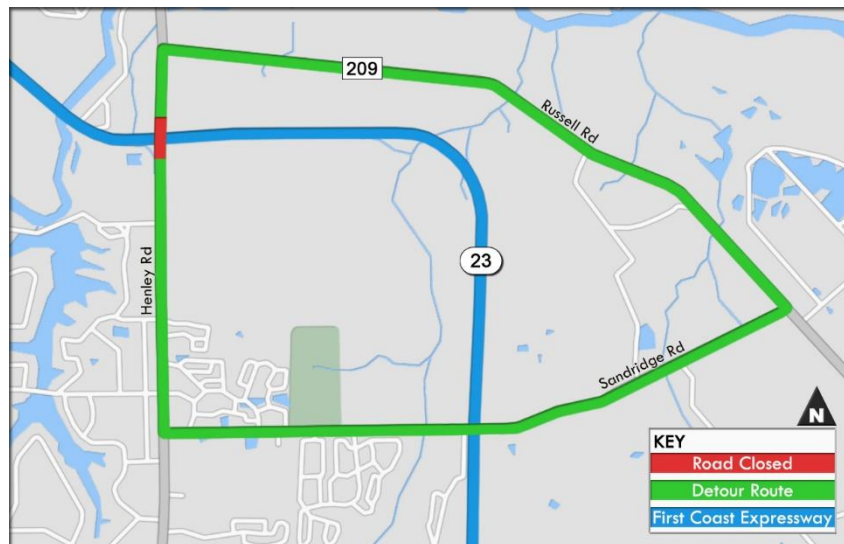

Overnight Detour of Henley Road Planned for Nov. 1 and 2

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – As part of construction of the First Coast Expressway (State Road 23), Henley Road between Lake Asbury Road and Caleb Court will close overnight Tuesday, Nov. 1 and Wednesday, Nov. 2. The roadway will close at 9 p.m. each night and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning. The closure will allow crews to set the beams for the First Coast Expressway overpass over Henley Road.

During the closures, traffic will be detoured via Russell Road and Sandridge Road as shown in the map below.



October is National Pedestrian Safety Month, and all roadway users share the responsibility for keeping everyone safe. Pedestrians should always use designated crosswalks and avoid distractions like using cell phones while walking.
