

Overnight Detour of Sandridge Road Rescheduled for September 22

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – The overnight closure of Sandridge Road at the future First Coast Expressway overpass originally planned for September 23 has been rescheduled for Wednesday, September 22 due to changes in supply availability. The roadway will close Wednesday at 9 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m. Thursday, September 23 to allow for pouring of a concrete bridge deck for the First Coast Expressway. Access will remain available for residents and local traffic. The overnight closure scheduled for September 30 will not be affected.

During the closure, motorists will be detoured via Henley Road and Russell Road as shown in the map below.
