Overnight Detour of State Road 202 Eastbound Exit Ramp to Hodges Boulevard Planned Next Week for Striping Work

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – In order for the Florida Department of Transportation’s maintenance crews to safely complete re-striping work, an overnight detour of the State Road 202 (J.T. Butler Boulevard) eastbound exit ramp to Hodges Boulevard is scheduled to occur from 9 p.m. Wednesday, Oct.18 through 5 a.m. Thursday, Oct.19, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During the closure, drivers will be detoured northbound on San Pablo Road, westbound on Beach Boulevard, and then south on Hodges Boulevard.
