Overnight Detours Starting Sunday on I-295 North Interchange Project

Jacksonville, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will implement overnight detours next week as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project.

Sunday, September 27:

I-95 northbound and southbound underneath I-295 is expected to be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

As show in the map below, drivers on I-95 northbound will be detoured to U.S. 17 and onto I-295 eastbound where they can rejoin I-95 northbound.



As shown in the map below, drivers on I-95 southbound will be detoured onto I-295 eastbound to U.S. 17 onto I-295 westbound where they can access I-95 southbound.



Monday, September 28 through Thursday, October 1:

The I-95 southbound ramp to I-295 westbound is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Drivers who wish to exit onto I-295 westbound from I-95 southbound will be detoured onto I-295 eastbound onto U.S. 17 where they can access I-295 westbound.



Wednesday, September 30 and Thursday, October 1:

The I-295 eastbound ramp to I-95 southbound is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Drivers will be detoured onto Airport Road where they can rejoin I-95 southbound.

This work is part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project that includes a new collector-distributor system, auxiliary lanes and ramp improvements. The interchange is part of an important corridor to promote economic growth and development in the region.

FDOT selected Archer Western to complete this \$176.8 million project in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
