Overnight Detours at the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Begin March 16

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the FDOT's I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements Project, overnight closures and detours begin Sunday, March 16 for roadway and bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closures scheduled Sunday, March 16 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **On U.S. 17 at I-295**, northbound drivers will detour to Busch Drive, to I-95 North and take Airport Center Drive to reconnect with U.S. 17. Southbound drivers will detour to I-295 East, to the Pulaski Road exit, to I-295 West to I-95 South and take Busch Drive to reconnect with U.S. 17.

Closures scheduled Sunday, March 16 through Thursday, March 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **At the I-295 West exit to I-95 North**, drivers will detour to U.S. 17 and take Airport Center Drive to connect with I-95 North.
- **At the I-295 East exit to I-95 North**, drivers will detour to U.S. 17 and take Airport Center Drive to connect with I-95 North.
- **On I-95 North at the I-295 Interchange**, drivers will detour to I-295 East, take the U.S. 17 exit and take Airport Center Drive to reconnect with I-95 North.
- **On I-295 East at the I-95 Interchange**, drivers will detour to I-95 North, to Airport Center Drive and take U.S. 17 to reconnect with I-295 East.
- **On I-295 West at the I-95 Interchange**, drivers will detour U.S. 17, to Airport Center Drive and take I-95 South to reconnect with I-295 West.

Archer Western was awarded the contract to complete \$176.8 million project. Work is expected to be completed in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
