

Overnight Detours of Henley Road Planned Nov. 13-16

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – As part of construction of the First Coast Expressway (State Road 23), Henley Road between Lake Asbury Road and Caleb Court will close at 7 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 13 and Monday, Nov. 14 and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning. The road will close at 9 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 15 and Wednesday, Nov. 16 and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning. The closures will allow crews to set beams for the First Coast Expressway overpass over Henley Road.

Traffic will be detoured via Russell Road and Sandridge Road, shown in the map below.
