Overnight Ramp Closures at Butler Boulevard, San Pablo Road Interchange Planned for Sunday and Monday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the interchange improvement project at J. Turner Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road, overnight closures of the ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard are planned for Sunday, June 12 and Monday, June 13, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The closures are necessary to complete paving work.

The ramp will be closed from 8 p.m. Sunday, June 12 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 13 and again from 8 p.m. Monday, June 13 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, June 14. Traffic will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard to South Beach Parkway, where drivers can access westbound Butler Boulevard.

FDOT selected Watson Civil Construction, Inc. to complete this \$12 million project in summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
