## **Overnight Resurfacing Scheduled Next Week on Northbound State Road 211 (St. Johns and Riverside Avenues)**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of the State Road 211 resurfacing project from San Juan Avenue to I-95, nightly northbound closures of State Road 211 (St. Johns and Riverside avenues) are scheduled Sunday, April 13 through Friday, April 18 for milling and paving work to be completed.

The following locations are scheduled for milling and paving next week between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.:

- Northbound State Road 211 from Van Wert Avenue to Edgewood Avenue in the Avondale neighborhood.
- Northbound SR 211 from Powell Place to Barrs Street.

The following location is scheduled for milling and paving next week between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.:

- Northbound SR 211 from Riverside Park Place to Peninsular Place.

This work will be performed using lane closures and flagging operations. Street parking on northbound Riverside Avenue in these locations will be unavailable at these times.

Watson Civil Construction was selected to complete the \$11 million project, which includes milling and resurfacing, shoulder treatment, sidewalk and ADA curb upgrades, new bike lanes and shared-use lane markings, signals, highway signage, traffic calming features and pedestrian lighting upgrades.
