Painting to Begin Next Week on Northbound I-95 Ramp to Acosta Bridge


Jacksonville – Work is expected to begin August 20 on painting, incidental repairs and other minor improvements to the ramp from the northbound I-95 service road onto the Acosta Bridge.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project, and existing posted speed limits will remain in place. Most project work will take place overnight, seven days a week. No lane closures will be permitted between 5:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Lane closure notices will be available at www.nflroads.com.

Southeast Bridge Florida Corporation is expected to complete the nearly \$300,000 project by late 2018, weather and schedule permitting.
